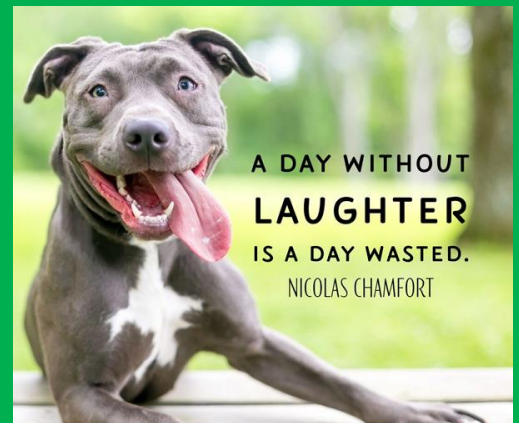

Instructions

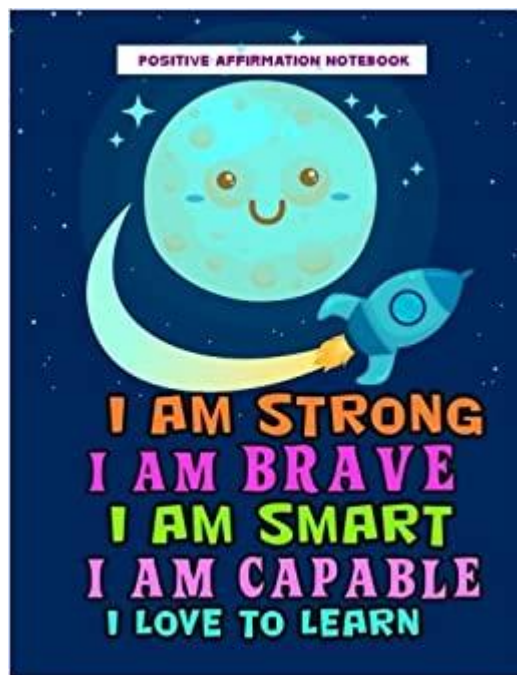
Whizz the berries, yogurt and milk together with a stick blender until smooth.
