We have enjoyed seeing some of the learning you have sent through to the year group email – it is great to see the fun you are having with the activities set.

Below is a suggested timetable for the children to follow for the week, however feel free to make adjustments to suit your routines at home.

*In addition, please make time for some exercise and reading. If there are outstanding pieces of work from last week’s suggestions these can be completed at any time.

Below is a detailed outline of instructions and expectations for these sessions: *(All work can be completed on the worksheet, in the exercise book supplied in the learning packs before the Easter break, or on any available notebooks/paper at home)*

Spellings	There are links to two spellings lists. Most children in Year 5 will require the Year 5 Spellings document. Children in Mrs Kidby’s group will require the Mrs Kidby group document. <u>On Monday</u> , children need to practice the new words - learning the new spelling rule using ‘look, cover, write and check’. <u>On Wednesday</u> , children need to look up the definitions of each word and write it down. <u>On Friday</u> , children need to write a sentence using the spelling word.
English	Children need to work through the English Workbook as suggested on the timetable. This workbook has two extracts to answer questions on; ‘Richest Boy in the World’ is found on page 28 of the booklet, along with other poems that can be read and explored independently and ‘My Cousin is a Time Traveller’ starts on page 32 of the booklet. There are some spelling and grammar activities to be completed within the booklet too. Please be assured that these documents do not need to be printed, the children can work from the screen and write answers in their exercise book or wherever is convenient.
Maths	Maths will consist of the following 3 elements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online activities on Mathletics (weekly homework) • White Rose daily online lessons and worksheets • Maths practise tests (weekly)

	<p>Mathletics homework will be set each week for children to complete. Once the homework has been completed, children are able to explore the rest of the site, playing Maths games individually or competing with others in their year group.</p> <p>Miss Cleere's and Mrs Kyei's maths groups: The White Rose Maths website have supplied some excellent Maths resources to use at home. Please follow the link: https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-5/ and complete the 5 lessons in 'Week 2'. These lessons continue with the topic of decimals. We are working two weeks behind the schedule on the website so please check the tasks set here. Each lesson has a video to explain, a worksheet to complete and answers to check progress. The White Rose Maths Team will also be online each weekday between 10.00 and 11.00am – a great opportunity for your child to show and share their work, ideas and ask questions every day.</p> <p>If your child completes the Mathletics and White Rose activities and would like to challenge themselves further, then please try and do a practise test each week. This can also be found on the White Rose website as well as links to Power Maths textbooks to help children revise any topics of Maths already covered. There is an additional Maths document for children to do if they have time.</p> <p>Mrs Steele's Maths group: The home learning Maths material for Year 5 consists of the following three elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online activities on Mathletics (weekly homework) • Online WhiteRose lessons and worksheets (daily-start at Summer Term Week 2 (w/c 27th April)) • Maths practise tests (weekly – hard copies previously provided)
Science	<p>Children will be starting a new unit on Forces. The first lesson includes a Powerpoint and resources to accompany it. There is also a lesson plan to follow. These activities can be completed over 2 days.</p>
History	<p>We are starting our summer term topic of World War One. For the children to understand the actions leading up to the war, there is a comprehension activity for them to read and answer questions. The answers will be uploaded to the website under extra resources.</p> <p>There is also a PowerPoint with extra information about life during the First World War that the children can read through. Questions are embedded throughout.</p> <p>Other websites such as https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zqhyb9q have lots of information that children can explore to find out more about the First World War.</p>

In the extra resources file, you can find answers to the Science and History tasks, if you wish to check through your child's understanding. Additionally, there is a flyer for a national computing competition (BCS Bedford Competition) if your child would like to enter.
